Play through these half cadences (another name is imperfect cadences). Transpose into all MAJOR keys up to two sharps or flats. Label soprano voice with scale degrees. Write the functional chord symbol below each chord. Are there common tones in IV and V? Are there common tones in II or ii and V?



Play through these half cadences. Transpose and play in all MINOR keys up to two sharps or flats.

Notice how a melodic augmented second is avoided in the same voice. Notice how ii is not in root position in minor.

Label the scale degrees in the soprano voice. Write the functional chord symbol below each chord. (inversions are possible)



Play through these half cadences. Notice the common tone voice leading. Write the functional chord symbols, and soprano scale degrees. Transpose and play in all MAJOR AND MINOR KEYS up to two sharps and flats.



Play through these **incorrect** half cadences. Write the soprano scale degrees and functional chord symbols. Can you circle and explain what's wrong with each one?
