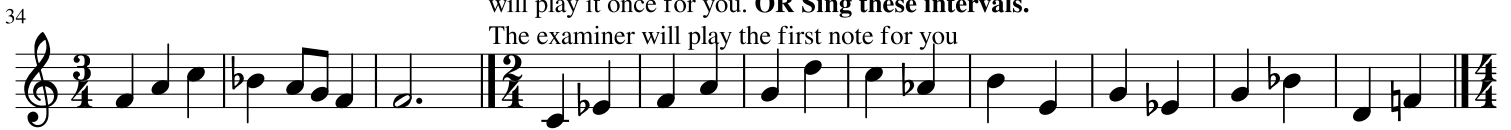


Level 2 Ear training review

Clapback: The examiner will play it twice, and then after you clap the rhythm back. The examiner will tell you the time signature and count one measure before beginning.

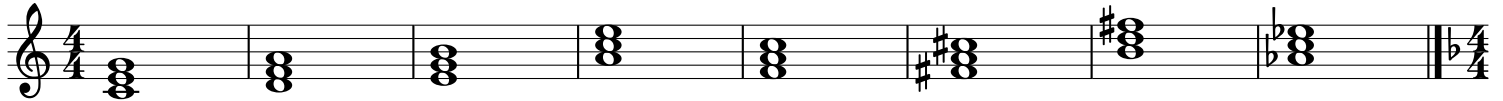


Name these intervals. The examiner will play it once for you. **OR Sing these intervals.** The examiner will play the first note for you

45 **Chords:** The examiner will play the chord once. Is it major or minor?



Playback: The examiner will tell you the key (F major, D minor, G major) and will play the triad once. then play the melody twice.

53 The first note will either be the tonic (first note of scale) or dominant (fifth note of scale). The notes in the playback are only going to be from the first five notes of the scale (pentascale)
